Elementary / Middle School

Parent/Teacher Conferences play an integral part in the academic growth of your child. Conferences are scheduled three times a year.

Winter Parent/Teacher conferences will be held:

School Closing Procedures

School closing decisions are made by administrative staff with the safety of students in mind. Adverse weather conditions and other emergency situations may make it necessary to cancel school. In the event of a school closing, an announcement will be made by text message and email through the school communication system and local radio and television stations.

If school is already in session when a severe weather watch or warning is issued, the school will stay open and staff will take safety precautions. Students are released to parents/guardians or designated adults listed on the family emergency form upon request.

Procedimientos de cierre de la Escuela

Las decisiones de cierre de la escuela se realizan por el personal administrativo con la seguridad de los estudiantes en mente. Las condiciones climáticas adversas y otras situaciones de emergencia pueden hacer que sea necesario para cancelar la escuela. En el caso de un cierre de la escuela, un anuncio se hará a través de mensajes de texto y correo electrónico a través del sistema de comunicación escuela y las estaciones de radio y televisión locales.

Si la escuela ya está en sesión cuando se emite un aviso de tiempo severo o advertencia, la escuela permanecerá abierta y el personal tomará las precauciones de seguridad.
