Tuition Calculation 2019-2020

Tuition Per Child (actual cost of education):

Preschool – 3 years by 9-1-2019 (2 half-days)	\$1,000.00
Pre-K – 4 years by 9-1-2019 (3 half-days)	\$1,550.00
Young-5 or Kindergarten (3-day)	\$4,700.00

To determine your family's approximate cost of tuition when applying for tuition assistance, use the following worksheet.

A copy of this year's 1040 tax forms, copies of your W2 forms and documentation of any extraordinary expenses will be required to apply for tuition assistance at enrollment.

Excessive medical costs (those claimed as income tax deductions), childcare costs, and court ordered payments may be considered in the calculation of tuition costs.

If you have three or more students enrolled in The Potter's House, the percentage will increase an additional .5%. For instance, if your family has three students enrolled in the school, you would multiply line 3 by 11% or .11 to determine your family's tuition responsibility.

1. Adjusted Gross Income on IRS 1040 Tax Form _____

3. Subtract line 2 from line 1 _____
4. If line 3 is less than \$50,000, Multiply line 3 by 10.5% (.105)* _____

Note regarding income: Please note that if line 3 is \$50,000 or greater, the tuition percentage of line 4 will increase by .5% increments for every \$5,000 over \$50,000. For example, if line 3 equals \$50,000 the rate will be 11%, if line 3 equals \$55,000, the rate will be 11.5% until \$100,000 or 16%.

Line 4 reveals an estimate of the maximum tuition that your family will pay; the minimum tuition for a qualifying family is \$650. This is an approximate calculation and should not be considered the final tuition cost. Tuition will be determined at the time of enrollment.

Tuition is paid in 10 monthly installments by cash or check, or 12 monthly, 26 bi-weekly or 52 weekly debits from a checking or savings account. The first tuition payment for current families will be due August 1, 2018.

For new families, the first month's payment is due at enrollment. This deposit is non-refundable; but will be applied toward the family's tuition.
