### **GUIDELINES FOR TABLE HOSTS**

#### What are my responsibilities as a table host?

- A table host's job is to fill a table at the banquet. Each table seats 8-10 people
  including yourself. You may host as many tables as you'd like and there is no cost
  to host a table.
- Can't fill all 10 seats? We'd still love for you to host any number of guests and TPH will fill the remaining seats.
- At the end of the program, you will be asked to collect the pledge cards from your guests.
- Please inform potential guests that this is a fundraising event.
